



Husch has seen several generations of family over the years and now the fourth generation is toddling through the winery. At age 5 Morgan Joseph (Mojo) isn't quite a full-fledged winemaker, but he is a favorite with the tasting room staff and visitors. It is no surprise that the Mojo Red has developed a loyal following: high quality estate-bottled wine from a local producer at an affordable price is a growing rarity these days.

The 2006 vintage is a Cabernet Sauvignon based wine that is ready to drink tonight. Our winemaking allows us to mellow the tannins of the wine quickly so the wine is approachable at a young age. Approach this wine with high expectations; despite the price this wine is hand crafted in small batches. The blend includes 24% Carignane.

The 2006 vintage offers a deep ruby color. Aromas reminisce of plum, black cherry and blackberry, with a hint of tobacco and clove. The wine offers similar flavors, good tannins, a nice structure and a little cedar on the finish.
