



Husch has seen several generations of family over the years and now the fourth generation is running through the winery. At age 7 Morgan Joseph (Mojo) isn't quite a full-fledged winemaker, but he is a favorite with the tasting room staff and visitors.

The Mojo Red is a Cabernet Sauvignon based wine that is affordable and ready to drink tonight. With the 2008 vintage we blended Cabernet Sauvignon (75%), Pinot Noir (12%) along with a touch of Syrah and Zinfandel. Approach this wine with high expectations; despite the price this wine is hand-crafted in small batches.

The 2008 vintage offers a deep violet color, aromas of cassis, cherry, pipe tobacco – with a hint of cedar and flint. Flavors of cassis, pepper violet, tobacco and smoked meat highlight the palate. The structure is firm, but not overwhelming with a hint of cherry, clay, and a pleasant, lingering finish. Try it with grilled steaks, pasta, pizza or your favorite burger.
