Husch has seen several generations of family over the years and now the fourth generation is running through the winery. At age 13 Morgan Joseph (Mojo) isn't quite a full-fledged winemaker, but he is a favorite with the tasting room staff and visitors. It is no surprise that the Mojo Red has developed a loyal following; high quality estate-bottled wine from a local producer at an affordable price is a growing rarity these days.

## Winemaking

The Mojo Red is a table wine that is affordable and ready to drink tonight. The 2014 release is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, aged in neutral oak barrels. Approach this wine with high expectations. Despite the price, this wine is hand-crafted in small batches, seeing the same love and attention that all our wines get.

## Tasting Notes

Don't stop to think too much, just enjoy! The deep color, layered aromas, and big fruit flavors make this wine a great everyday red. This wine pairs well with Mondays and Tuesdays, and can be enjoyed with any meal!
